

Approval of Meeting Minutes from December 9th: Motion to approve from Diane, Alisha seconded, all in favor

Treasurer's Report for December: Motion to approve from Andrea, Alisha seconded, all in favor Side note, SBA Loan – that was what we thought was a grant, but it was a loan so it cost us \$58.77 of interest

Committee Business

- Worship & Shepherding (Kelly, Lonnie)
 - Bill Pribula will run the service on Jan 31st when Rick is gone
- Stewardship (Diane, Andrea)
 - Giving Tree \$1,800 towards Churches United plus non-monetary donations; \$2,200 towards shed/bathroom. We have around \$1,700 to go towards the bathroom, but need someone to lead the project.
- Education (Randy, Alisha)
 - o No new news
- Properties/Grounds/Parsonage (Myron, Travers, Don)
 - Crossroad's addressed heater issues. The 0 regulator on fellowship hall had to be replaced. The sanctuary was manually put on emergency heat which is why the red light was on. Crossroad's set the schedule for 65 degrees as base heat. On Sundays it will automatically turn up to 70 degrees at 5:30 a.m., then go down to 68 degrees at 2 and back to 65 at 5 p.m. So except on Sundays, the Sanctuary will be at 65 unless we change it. If we need to change the heat, use the up/down arrows and then the up/down arrows on the time display for how long to hold it. In Fellowship Hall, the heat pumps were turned off because someone turned off the breakers. There was also a bird's nest in the exhaust pipe that got cleaned out. He set the regular temperature for 68 degrees. Crossroad's highly recommends

that not just anyone mess with the thermostats

- The lights were not working on the entrance doors, Myron couldn't find any bulbs in the church so went to Crossroad's and they advised for the price of 2 of those bulbs you can buy LED. It is \$125 a fixture and there are 5 of them so they were purchased
- Brian also asked about the yard light and who handles that. Andrea will check with Grace if she has any info on who we can contact
