

- Worship
 - Nothing to report
- Stewardship
- o Third quarter focus will again be on Lutheran Disaster Response with funds received going to help the people of Ukraine.
- Education
- Nothing to report Sunday school finished on April 24th.
- Properties/Grounds & Parsonage
- Altar Windows & Wooden frame around the stained-glass window in the back. Still waiting for construction estimate from Christopher Ferderer. Timeline would be sometime this summer or fall depending on availability.
- o Landscape bricks for flower beds The Wallins have some landscaping timbers made of cement that they are willing to donate to replace the rotting wood. Bill will look at what they have and what it would take to bring them in and install.
- o Rick reported there is a sink hole north of the parsonage. He's been trying to fill it by hand but needs to have more dirt. Kelly Arth said Jesse will deliver a bucket load of dirt with his bobcat.
- Egress Window covers Bill brought a brochure from Jim's Custom Egress Covers with photos showing some covers that may possibly work for the church to keep things out of the window wells. He will follow-up.

Pastor's Report

- Vacation request: May 29th and June 12th. Bill will lead worship on the 29th and we will look at finding a replacement for June 12th.

Those will need to be upgraded in order to be able to stream to this tv. DRN made some suggestions regarding upgrading to business hardware waiting on a quote on cost of upgrade.
