Secretary and treasurer's report reviewed. Motion made by Kelly Arth to accept and approve reports, seconded by Randy Syrstad. Motion carried.

#### **Committee Business:**

Worship (Kelly Arth, Deb Wagner)

- Discussed having a reminder added to the bulletin weekly regarding the offering plate in the back on the piano. Also suggested that we start having the Shepherding group assigning 1 or 2 ushers again mainly to direct things such as putting up Hymn numbers, walking the offering up during the offering song, counting and greeting. They would not need to shake hands or hand out bulletins, but just be present and ensuring things are done.
   Diane will follow-up with the Shepherding leaders.
- A suggestion from a congregational member was made to alternate offering song between Create in Me and We are an offering. Will talk with Heidi regarding possibly alternating monthly.

### Stewardship (Diane Wallin, DeNae Mahler)

- Churches United is focus for Stewardship for this quarter. Diane discussed having Peter Hinderlie, who is now a case manager with Churches United, come down and do a temple talk. This suggestion was approved council and Pastor Rick. Diane will coordinate this for some time in November.

- It was suggested by a member of the church that we look at installing a T in the sewer pipes to help keep them open in the upcoming winter as there

was some issue with them freezing up last year. Myron will check into this.

**Pastor's Report:** Pastor will be gone next Sunday; Bill will lead the service and read Rick's sermon. There have been a couple of weddings past couple weeks and he will be doing a funeral in Lidgerwood tomorrow per request of a family.

Old Business: Discussion had regarding special events, contract for renting and cleaning for events. We have no formal written contract with custodian regarding extra cleaning for events, only a verbal agreement with previous council. Would like to get that formalized. Number of events differ from year to year making it difficult to budget but discussed possibility of adding a line-item expense in next year's budget for events to be used to defray extra cost of cleaning.

#### **New Business:**

- Pastor's contract will be up in December, so we will need to review this. Also discussed possible new parsonage project of walling in the central air unit that sits in middle of the basement. This would help with the loudness when running. We will have money left over from the bathroom project once all the bills are paid.
- WELCA wants permission to get rid of the display cabinet in fellowship hall where cards were displayed as it is no longer used. Council had no concerns regarding this.
