

Immanuel Lutheran Council Minutes August 22, 2023

The Council met on August 22nd at Immanuel Lutheran Church. Present were Pastor Bryant, Mindy Hogness, Tanner Martinson, Kevin Moxness, and Landon Mund. Mindy called the meeting to order.

The Secretary's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Tanner, seconded by Kevin. The Treasurer's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Landon, seconded by Tanner. Pastor Rick gave his report, informing the council he is pleased with the work done to start a new Sunday School program at ILC. He also touched on Confirmation classes coming up soon, with a start date likely between late September and early October. Lastly, Pastor Bryant mentioned that he is planning to take vacation time around late October and early November.

Committees:
