The meeting was opened with Devotions from Pastor Rick. Secretary and Treasurer's reports were reviewed—Correction added regarding Secretary and Treasurers report last month. It was noted that this month there was a significant jump in water bill at the parsonage. Rick will check with the City on this. Motion made to approve the Secretary and treasurers report by Kris Lien and seconded by Nate Sundquist; motion carried.

Committee reports:

Worship –The committee met recently and hymns were picked thru April.

<u>Stewardship</u> – Noisy offering is scheduled for April 14th. Donations will be given to YMCA. Linda Costain has also arranged for a special speaker for church that day. Education

- Sunday School kids will sing in church on Palm Sunday— March 24th. They will also have their annual breakfast after church.
- No Confirmation during lent, will resume after Easter.
- Wednesday soup and sandwich hosted by Luther League has been going very well.
- Need to start thinking about 1st communion class's once Easter is over. Will followup on this at next meeting.

Properties/Grounds & Parsonage

- Exterior wood on bottom of the stained-glass windows.
 Nate talked with the contractor who fixed the altar windows and he has been here to look at the project and will let us know.
- Humidity issue in basement Crossroads was here and gave a recommendation regarding humidity control in basement. Kris will follow up with Jason regarding the previous estimate that he had received and we will review at next meeting.
- Gutter hanging down on south side of church. tabled until spring.
- Weeds in the grass at the church and parsonage tabled until spring.
- Drainage around church in front of door tabled until spring.
- Sprayers for 2 of the sinks in the kitchen were replaced.
- Heat pumps in the fellowship hall are still having issues.
 Crossroads was able to get one working and has ordered parts for second heat pump. He will reach out to Jill when that is available.

 It was brought to council's attention that the external sign is looking tough: Grounds committee will follow up on this.

Pastor's Report: We are in week 4 of Lent. There is a baptism this Sunday. Pastor will be working on a new members Sunday and make announcement in church to see if there is further interest. We have a few new families that are attending regularly. Pastor discussed Easter Services and it was decided to continue 2 services on Easter, 6:30AM Sunrise and 10am service.

- Discussed option for substitute organist through Church Music Solutions. This is a service that would record service music to be then played through iPad device through our sound system. Deb will look into this further.
- We have a CD coming due this month and this will be renewed.
