January 10, 2024

Meeting was called to order by President Bill Pribula.

Secretary's & Treasurer's Reports were reviewed.

There were some questions regarding money given to synod for the year. Grace attended the meeting and clarified that the budgeted amount was paid in 2 lumps, last payment in December. No further questions voiced. Motion made to approve the reports by Jill Baldwin and seconded by Kris Lien, motion carried.

Committee Business

- Worship (Deb & Jill) nothing new to report.
- Stewardship (DeNae & Jason) nothing new to report.
- Education (Randy & Alisha) nothing new to report. No Sunday School this weekend, will resume on $21_{\rm st}$.
- Properties/Grounds & Parsonage (Bill, Kris & Nate) Exterior wood on bottom of the stained-glass windows. The council was informed that the contractor that had previously agreed to do this project is no longer doing this kind of work. Nate will talk with the contractor that replaced the altar windows to see if he would be able to do this.
- Church floor tile tiles have been replaced.
- Humidity issue in basement We are still waiting on Crossroads to give us a bid.
- Gutter hanging down on south side of church – Nate was not able to get to this prior to winter setting in, so will be looked at in the spring.
- Window air conditioner for parsonage garage – removing this for now. Will revisit as needed.
- Weeds in the grass at the church and parsonage – tabled until spring.

O Drainage around church in front of door. Not able to dig this out due to material that was used. Will readdress this in the spring once things have warmed up. There has been no drainage issues as far as snow and ice so far this winter.

Pastor's Report - Pastor Rick unable to attend the meeting, so no update currently.

Old Business

- Council Size -2nd Congregational notice was given in December. The change to allow Council size to flex odd numbers from 5-9 will be voted on at the annual meeting.
- The annual meeting will be held January 28th. Deb Wagner will be unable to attend so Jill Baldwin will record the minutes. We have 3 outgoing council members this year, and we have some people that are interested in the council positions. We are waiting for the final decision from them.

New Business

- Final Budget reviewed with Grace. She will let Immanuel know of the change in their contribution for 2024.
- Jill reported that there is a visitation and pastoral care workshop in Cogswell on January 13th. She is planning on trying to attend. Jill has also expressed interest in pursuing lay ministry and would be interested in this as a possible avenue to volunteer as a supplement to current ministry @ MLC.

A motion was made by Jill Baldwin and seconded by Kris Lien to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. Next Meeting February 7th @ 6:15pm due to Lent starting on the 14th.

The Secretary's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Tanner, seconded by Kevin. The Treasurer's Report was read and a motion to approve was made by Landon, seconded by Kevin. There was no Pastor's Report.

Committees:

- Education: Sunday School resumed on January 14th; Kelsy Martinson & Kylie Martinson are co-teaching this Spring.
